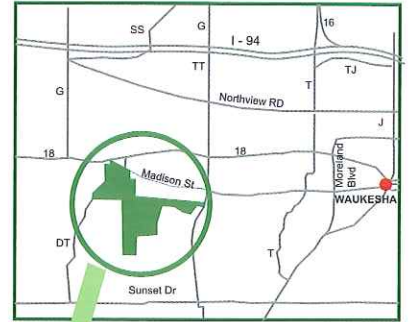

(Approximately 1 mile west.)

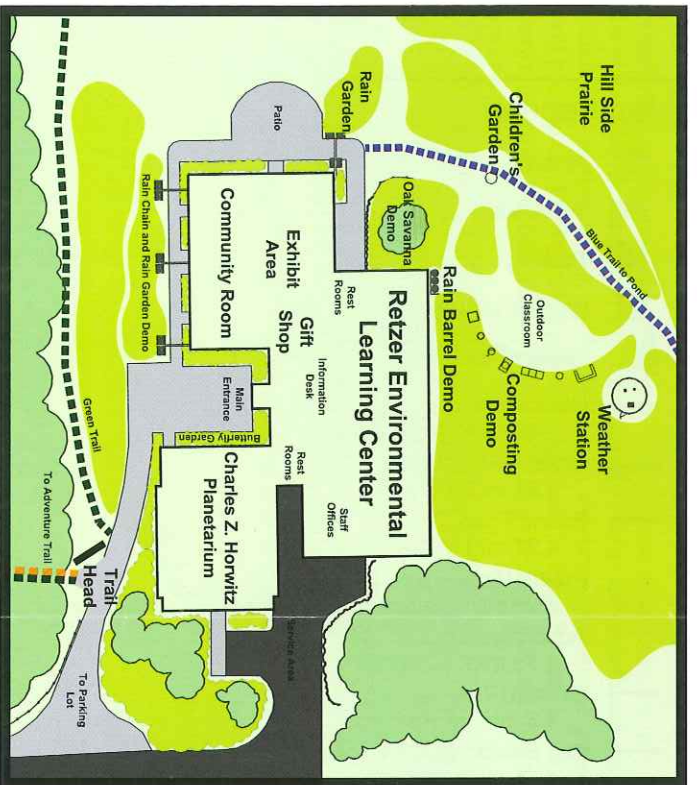

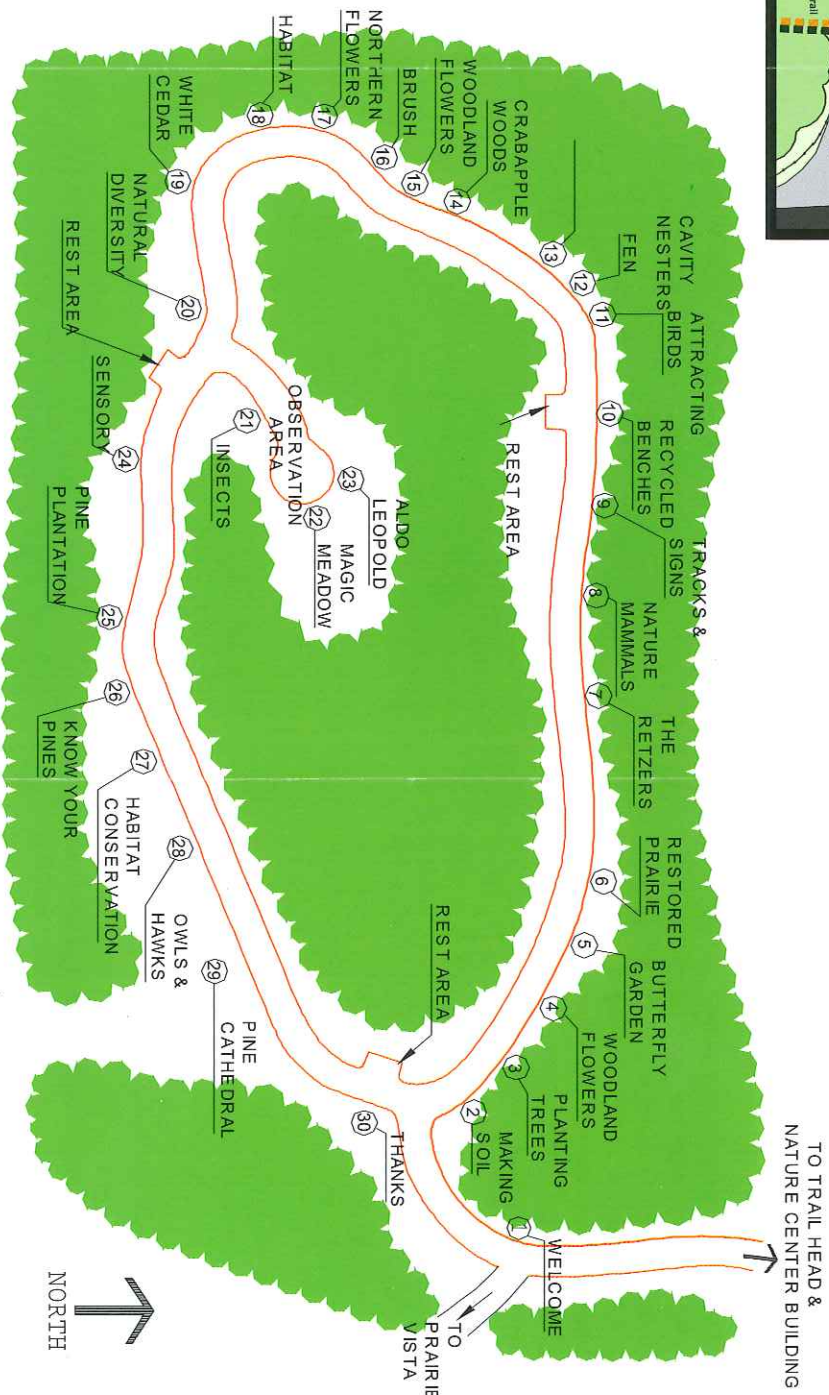

Outdoor Educational Demonstrations

Retzer Nature Center allows visitors to learn by example with our demonstration areas. Both brochures and workshops are available for the following areas around the building.
